The great Vaishanava devotional movement picked up momentum after the Vedanta propounded by Sri Madhvacharya of South India in the 13<sup>th</sup> century, AD. The followers stressed devotion through melodious songs called "Devaranaama". They conveyed great spiritual truths in simple and elegant Kannada, the regional language, making religion, prayers and devotion accessible to common people. Often in these songs Lord Vishnu, Lord Krishna or Vittala of Pandarpur, and Hampi in Karnataka as well as Srinivasa of Tirupati are referred to. Today's selections are songs written by six Saints from the 15 through 18<sup>th</sup> century.
