Dhanteras falls two days before Diwali. On this day, houses and business premises are renovated and decorated. "**Lakshmi-Puja**" is performed in the evenings when tiny Diyas of clay are lighted to drive away the shadows of evil spirits. Traditionally, people perform Dhan (Silver Coin) Puja on this day. Kali Choudas:

Kali means Dark (evil) and Chaudas - Fourteenth. Thus, celebrated 14th day of Ashwin, Kali Chaudas is the day allotted to the worship of Maha-Kali or Shakti. On this day we also offer puja to Hanumanji as our Kuldev to protect us from Evil. Coconuts, prasad of Sesame seed, ladoos and rice are offered to Hanumanji.
