Karva Chauth - which falls on the fourth day after full moon in the *Kartik* month of the Hindu calendar, is one of the most important fasts observed by married Hindu women. The fast begins before sunrise and ends only after offering prayers and worshipping the moon at night. During late afternoon, women get together to perform *Puja* and listen to the narration of the "*Katha*" or the legend of **Karva Chauth**. Henna or *Mehendi*, considered to be auspicious for married women, is a necessary part of the **Karva Chauth** ritual.
