He has a unique style of presenting even complex subject matter, due to his clarity and great sense of humor. He is based in Surat, India but spends a few months every year teaching at Arsha Vidya Gurukulam, Saylorsburg, PA and at spiritual centers around the U.S.

At BCC, he will give an introduction to and overview of the Atharvashirsha Mahamantra, a Sanskrit hymn praising Lord Ganesha. It is recited as part of many Hindu ceremonies and is especially chanted on Sankashta Chaturthi Day. At BTI's Annual Ganesh Chaturthi Festival, one of the highlights is the recitation of this hymn by a group of children!
